It measures a person's proficiency with using Internet browsers and common desktop applications, such as email, chat and word processing programs. The test consists of three 3-minute task-oriented simulations, followed by ten multiple choice questions covering knowledge of internet browsers, basic cybersecurity, calendars and universal operating system features. Since it is designed as a test of the kind of basic computer literacy that is required in many work environments, it can be used for any position which requires basic computer skills, such as receptionists, customer service representatives, medical billers, data entry clerks, administrative assistants, and more.


